

Consultative Packages for School Districts

Consult Packages are a flexible way for the district to access our supports on a regular basis.

Consultative Packages include any combination of:

- Support for existing technology, augmentative communication, and solutions for reading and writing.
- Direct instruction/therapy for students learning to use assistive technology or augmentative communication.
- Formal Evaluation/Consultation Services
- Consultation for individual students, classrooms, or programs
- Meeting participation
- Team training/staff development
- Device programming and technical support
- System wide consultation regarding augmentative communication services, assistive technology or system policies and procedures in these areas.

Consultative Packages are available on a **Monthly** or **Weekly** Basis:

Monthly:

- 1/2 day (up to 3 hours) per month; 10 visits per year
- 1 day (up to 7 hours) per month; 10 visits per year
- 2 days per month (up to 14 hours); 20 visits per year
- 3 days per month (up to 21 hours); 30 visits per year

Weekly:

- 1/2 day per week (up to 3 hours), 35 visits per year
- 1 day per week (up to 7 hours), 35 visits per year

Custom packages are also available. If your district needs do not fit this model, please call and we will work with you to meet your needs. Please note that Consultative Packages do not include pursuing third party (i.e., Medicaid, private insurance) funding for technology.

Benefits of a Consultative Package include:

- The flexibility to change priorities without additional paperwork or rescheduling. Examples might include staff changes mid-year, or when a new student moves into district.
- The consultant can provide “big picture” input to districts for sustainable change over time.
- For various reasons, a formal evaluation might not be appropriate or even necessary. However, a student or team may benefit from input from the consultant. Having the ability to problem-solve and brainstorm with the consultant without a formal evaluation saves time and financial resources.
- Regularly scheduled services reduce coordination demands; services are scheduled out for the year.
- Teams can explore and trial solutions in a timely manner.
